Multimedia Pathway



1 MULTIMEDIA COMMUNICATIONS DESIGN 10 CREDITS/UC-F

Develop a broad range of skills and knowledge in the fundamental elements and principles of art, design, and multimedia communications. Learn and apply basic skills in industry-standard digital media software programs including the Adobe Creative Suite in a variety of projects across different media formats: print, animation, and web design.

2 ADVANCED MEDIA ARTS PORTFOLIO 10 CREDITS, PRE-REQUISITE: MCD

This capstone course builds upon the knowledge and skill developed in Multimedia Communications Design in a project-based environment. Course work will focus on creative components of graphic design, photography, computer, and video production application in both the educational and industry settings. Students will create media arts products that demonstrate relevant workforce skills and a comprehensive knowledge of industry practices.

Entrepreneurship Pathway



1 SMALL BUSINESS BOOT CAMP 10 CREDITS/UC-G

The Small Business Boot Camp course combines steps to starting a business, skills needed to operate a business and roles within a business in conjunction with the Career Technical Education; Marketing, Sales, and Services Sector. Students will explore Entrepreneurship, general business practices, departments within a company, and personal branding, with an overall emphasis on what it takes to start and operate a small business. Students will also create a business plan and professional portfolio.

2 ENTREPRENEURSHIP II 10 CREDITS/UC-G, PRE-REQUISITE: SBB

The Entrepreneurship II course is designed for students who want to elevate their entrepreneurial and business leadership skills. This advanced course builds upon the foundational knowledge and skills gained from the Entrepreneurship I course, Small Business Bootcamp. Students will dive into advanced topics essential for successfully managing and growing a business by exploring business operations, strategic thinking, innovation, marketing, financial management, and global entrepreneurship. Students will apply specific knowledge learned throughout the course to current real-world scenarios to equip them with the strategic thinking and decision-making skills necessary for entrepreneurial and business success.

Culinary Arts Pathway



1 CULINARY ARTS 10 CREDITS/UC-F

This course provides an exciting introduction to the world of culinary arts. As the first course in the Culinary Arts pathway, students will engage in hands-on learning, mastering fundamental cooking techniques, knife skills, ingredient preparation, and various cooking methods. The curriculum covers grains, pasta, pizza, proteins, and essential baking techniques, helping students build confidence in the kitchen while preparing delicious meals from scratch. Students will have the opportunity to earn the ServSafe Food Handlers certification.

Students who complete this course can continue their culinary journey by enrolling in the Advanced Culinary Arts course next summer or after school in the fall and spring with Coastline ROP, ultimately finishing the Culinary Arts pathway.
