



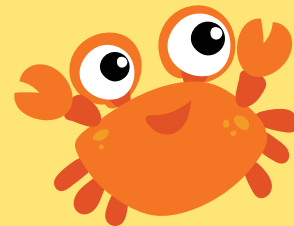

(If you are late for pick up, you will be charged a \$5 fine for every 15 minutes you are late without prior notice.)

 Please send your kid with water, snacks and lunch and wearing sunscreen.

 All participants are expected to follow the 4-H code of conduct that you sign when enrolling in 4-H. Failure to do so will result in immediate dismissal.

 If your child needs medication throughout the day, please hand it directly to Lina Howe, labeled and packed, at the beginning of each day.

 An adult that is on the custody release form needs to attend the youth inside the building for drop off and come in for pick up each day. We will not send a youth out to the car.



Summer Fun FAQ



Q- Do I need to fill out the enrollment form health questions?

A- Yes! We want to keep your youth safe and these are the most important part of your enrollment forms!



Q- My child is too young or too old for this camp, can I still sign up?

A- This can be accommodated on a case by case basis, call Mrs.Lina!



Q- I can't afford the cost of these camps up front of at all, is there anyway my child can still attend?

A- Yes! This is managed on a case by case basis but we offer scholarships and payment plans, reach out to Mrs. Lina



Q- My child has an allergy, disability, or other need, can those be accommodated?

A- Yes! 4-H is for everyone and we will do our best to ensure your child can participate.



Q- Can parents attend camps?

A- In 4-H we encourage kids being dropped off to help build independence and make the transition back to school in the fall easier, however they are welcome to attend as chaperones on field trips!



Q- How are refunds handled?

A- Refunds are not generally given unless an extenuating circumstance can be proven. If we can fill your slot from the waitlist we can give a partial refund sans fees.

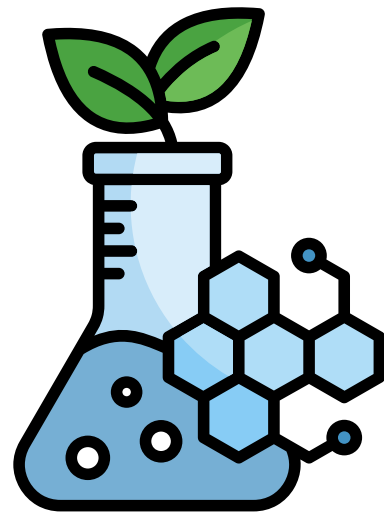

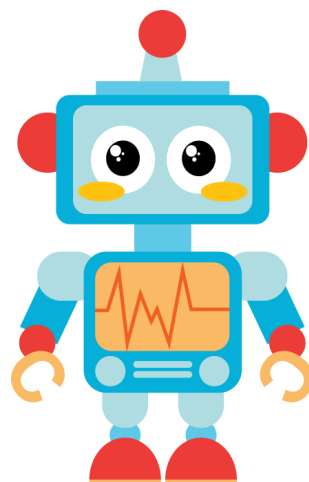

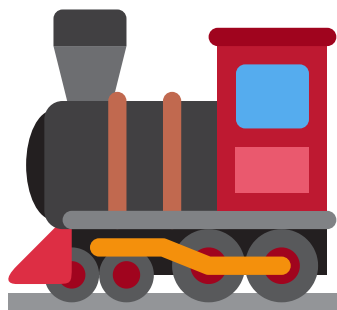
