



# COLTON JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ENGLISH LEARNER IDENTIFICATION PROCESS

**30 Day  
Process**

Administer Home Language Survey (HLS) at the time of enrollment to all new students in California

Parent/guardian answered Language other than English on at least one of the first 3 questions of HLS

Notify parent/ guardian(s) via enrollment that Initial English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPAC) will be administered

Before testing:  
Check student has a State Student ID (SSID) and To Be Determined "TBD" in Calpads

Call Parent to notify and schedule appointment for Initial ELPAC Test

Administer Initial English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPAC)

Parent/ guardian answered English Only on the first questions

Place in mainstream program No English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPAC) Testing



Identified English Learner (EL)  
Novice/Intermediate

Place in appropriate EL program  
Summative ELPAC required every Spring until Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP)

Identified Initially Fluent English Proficient (IFEP) (Not an English Learner)

Placed in mainstream program  
No summative English Language Proficiency (ELPAC) required

Notify parent or guardian(s) of Initial English Language Proficiency (ELPAC) results and program options
