


### **<u><b>WMCA Project Cornerstone**</u>

## AP Exams Begin May 5

AP Exams are quickly approaching and will take place May 5-May 16. You can click <u>here</u> to see what day your AP Exam is, and you can click <u>here</u> to see if your test is digital or on paper. In the two weeks before the test, you will receive information regarding your testing location and arrival time via email.

As AP Exams approach, there are many different ways that teachers help students prepare for exams. Two ways to prepare are practice problems and full-length practice exams. Please note the following information about practice problems and full-length practice exams.

- 1. Teachers might assign progress checks as practice problems on AP Classroom. If students receive a grade for progress checks, it will be a completion grade, not a grade that reflects the student's skill or percent correct.
- 2. If there is a graded full-length practice exam in your class, there will be an option to take this exam during the school day. Any practice exam given outside of the school day will not be required.
- 3. If a full-length practice exam is graded in your class, it will not count for more than the equivalent of a regular exam, and it will not be considered your final exam.
- 4. So that you have the chance to study for your exam(s), there will be no graded or required full-length practice exams after Friday, May 2.


**Note:** All game tickets are sold primarily through Go Fan; there is limited cash at the gate.
