Exam for Acceleration

If a student wishes to accelerate to the next grade level without having received prior instruction in the grade level, they will be permitted to take an exam to earn such credit. For example, a student currently in 3rd grade wants to "test out" of 4th grade and enter 5th grade in the fall of 2025. The student would take an exam in the 4 core subject areas- reading language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies - covering 4th grade TEKS. They would need to earn 90% on each exam to accelerate to the next grade.

The exams given by the district are approved by the district's board of trustees, and state law requires the use of certain exams. If a student plans to take an exam, the parent must register with the principal by May 9, 2025. Examen para Aceleración. Si un estudiante desea avanzar al siguiente grado sin haber recibido instrucción previa en ese grado, se le permitirá presentar un examen para obtener dicho crédito. Por ejemplo, un estudiante que cursa 3.er grado desea aprobar el 4.º grado e ingresar al 5.º grado en otoño de 2025. Presentaría un examen en las cuatro áreas temáticas principales: lectura, artes del lenguaje, matemáticas, ciencias y estudios sociales, que cubren los TEKS de 4.º grado. Necesitaría obtener un 90% en cada examen para avanzar al siguiente grado.

Los exámenes administrados por el distrito son aprobados por la junta directiva del distrito, y la ley estatal requiere el uso de ciertos exámenes. Si un estudiante planea tomar un examen, el padre debe registrarse con el director antes del 9 de mayo de 2025. WHAT IS KID CONNECTION?

JWE Kid Connection is an after-school program for enrolled children in 3rd through 5th grade. 3rd-5th grade Kid Connection will take place at Jacob's Well Elementary so that students are in a familiar and safe environment. Experienced WISD employees supervise the children at all times while they participate in enjoyable enrichment activities. Our experienced staff is caring and creative and our students have fun each day.

WHEN DOES IT OPERATE?

It is in session each full day of school. Hours are from afterschool-6:00 p.m. for \$250/month. JWE **Kid Connection does not operate on school holidays, waiver days, half-days on the yearly district calendar, or teacher in-service / workdays.** In the event of an **emergency closing**, the parent/guardian will be expected to pick up the child when all other children are dismissed at their original campus as this is necessary to keep students safe.

WHAT DO THE CHILDREN DO?

The children enjoy supervised classroom and recreational activities. Classroom activities will include homework time as well as enrichment and thematic activities revolving around literature and art. Recreation includes time to play on the playground and organized games. Children will also enjoy a snack together.

HOW DO I ENROLL MY CHILD?

Complete this registration form and pay a one-time **non-refundable** \$200 registration and snack fee (made payable to WISD). DURING THE YEAR SAFETY EXPECTATIONS:

Your child will only be released to individuals on your list. If we do not know the individual, we will request to see the driver's license.

PLAN AHEAD! If a change is needed in the after school routine, send a note to the homeroom teacher. If an emergency change is necessary, call the campus secretary and a note will be given to the child's teacher. *Please avoid frequent changes* so your child will feel comfortable with his or her after school plans and routine.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

The **non-refundable** registration and snack fee of \$200 is due upon enrollment. The tuition fee for the program is \$250 per month. **Tuition fees are due on the 1st day of each month, even if there is a holiday. A late fee of \$20.00 will be applied on the sixth day of the month. On the seventh day, the fee will increase to \$40.** The full tuition fee is due for each month August - May. The program begins on the first day of school.

How to Pay? Checks made payable to WISD or online at <https://wimberleyisd.revtrak.net>. The online system is set up by months. If you pay before the 1st of any month, *it will automatically charge you the late fee as it thinks it is the previous month's tuition.* For example, if you pay May's tuition on April 28th, the system thinks you are paying for April and automatically charges the late fee.

Snacks will be purchased using the above registration and snack fee. Please provide medical information from your pediatrician regarding any food allergy or medical needs.

- . There is a one-time non-refundable registration and snack fee of \$200 due upon enrollment.. This guarantees your child a spot in the program.
- Tuition is \$250 for the program payable to Wimberley ISD on the first school day of each month. A late fee of \$20 will apply (on the 6th day) of the month. On the 7th day, the late fee will increase to \$40. You may not skip a month of service without payment. For example, if your child does not attend in October, you will still owe for the month of October upon your return in November. We have a waiting list and we staff and continue to pay staff members to work regardless of whether your child is absent for a few weeks.
- Late fees will be assessed when parents pick up children beyond 6 pm. There will be a \$1.00 per minute/per child charge for late pick-up, which is payable at the time of pick-up. The clock in the JWE front office will be used to determine the fee amount.
- Children who repeatedly have inappropriate behavior, hurt themselves, others, or property, or fees that are overdue will be subject to dismissal. We will keep track of both discipline and overdue fees. Parents will be informed of discipline issues. Students who have more than five discipline referrals are subject to dismissal from the program.
- Staff members will not release the child to anyone but the parent or persons with permission that are listed on this form or unless specific arrangements have been made.
