<p>* Assumptions made in projecting a contingency budget for the 2025-26 school year, should the proposed budget be defeated pursuant to Section 2023 of the Education Law, would result in reductions in equipment purchases of \$87,535 and non-represented salaries of \$28,474. The contingency budget could be further reduced, depending on the Board of Education's discretionary use of district reserves to mitigate a 0% increase in the 2025-26 tax levy. Without the use of additional reserves, the contingency budget for the 2025-26 school year would be further reduced by \$655,087 to \$41,567,467.</p>
