

Poly/PAAL High School Senior 2025 PTSA Scholarship Guidelines

Poly/PAAL PTSA offers up to \$500 scholarships to **graduating high school seniors** at Poly/PAAL High School who will be enrolled full-time in an accredited college or university or a technical institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following applicant's high school graduation. All funds for the scholarships are provided on behalf of Poly/PAAL PTSA.

Through our scholarship program, Poly/PAAL PTSA works to support students who are focused on achieving career goals through higher education. In evaluating each application, the Scholarship Committee will also consider service and participation in high school activities, community involvement and scholastic merit.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior from Poly/PAAL High School with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Applicant must be a current member of the Poly/PAAL PTSA as of May 22, 2025. Name must appear on a membership roster and received by PTSA by May 22, 2025. Attached copy of PTSA Card.
 *The current membership year began in August 2025.
- Applicant must plan to be enrolled full-time in an accredited college or university or technical institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following high school graduation.
- Applicant cannot have an immediate family member on the PTSA 2025 Scholarship Committee.
- □ A completed application <u>must be received in the Poly Career Center via email by 5pm May 22,</u> <u>2025</u> to be eligible for consideration.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

To qualify, the applicant must complete the application which includes the following:

- □ Complete and submit application form.
- Submit a <u>résumé</u>, limited to one page, listing school activities, community involvement, special recognitions and any awards the applicant received in high school. Also, list any work experience during the high school years.
- □ On a separate piece of paper, answer the below questions and submit:
 - What are your future goals relating to education and/or career?
 - What is your greatest achievement and how has that impacted your life?
 - What will you do to give back to the community (pay-it-forward)?
- Copy of a high school transcript (does not have to be "official" copy) ***For official school use.**

Submit completed scholarship packet to the Poly Career Center-Ms. Sylvia Womack via email at swomack@lbschools.net by May 22, 2025.

SELECTION AND DISBURSEMENT Selection will be made by the Poly/PAAL PTA Scholarship Committee on **May 30, 2025**. Scholarship winners will be notified via email and U.S. mail. All disbursement checks will be given to the recipient by the PTSA board members. Checks will not be mailed to recipients.

All entries submitted to Poly/PAAL PTSA become property of Poly/PAAL PTSA.

Decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.
