By the numbers

The 2025-26 Proposed Budget includes a 1.69% tax levy in the budget supports a negative tax rate of -0.91%. This means residents will enjoy a tax decrease in this upcoming budget.


This is the 14th consecutive tax-cap compliant budget.

The 2025-2026 proposed budget continues to build upon the enhancement of instructional alignment, strengthening academic programs, and implementing academic initiatives in the following ways:

- Academic enhancements featuring complete implementation of FLES at Columbus, adoption of a new reading resource/program K-5, expansion of our strings program to grade 3, expansion of Science Research at WHS, the introduction of Anatomy & Physiology at WHS, and expanded mathematics and literacy enrichment opportunities
- Comprehensive security measures including our School Resource Officer, Altaris Security Coordinator, and completion of our three-tiered safety implementation approach
- Strategic facility infrastructure upgrades designed to complement our \$35.9 million Instructional Bond project addressing instructional spaces, and security enhancements.
- Funding to support additional classroom air cooling and the necessary infrastructure/electrical upgrades as needed.
- Additional mental health resources with expanded support for students, primarily at Westlake Middle School to
 support transitions Athletic program enhancements with uniform replacements, possible girls' flag football expansion,
 and a new scoreboard for the Westlake Middle School gymnasium
