



AP Testing Information

Hello AP Students!

Advanced Placement Exam Testing will run from Monday, May 5th to Friday, May 16th. You are responsible for knowing your exam schedule and location. Springfield Public Schools covers the cost of each AP exam for every student. However, families will be charged for the cost of any unused exam. Please contact Ms. Renelle immediately if you are aware of any conflict with the schedule. **The schedule is outlined on the following page.**

Prior to Exams

- Students must acknowledge that they agree to the AP Exam Terms and Conditions cb.org/apexamterms.
- Students should sign into Bluebook using their College Board student account and try to **test preview** questions.
- On the sign in screen in Bluebook, students should select “**Test Your Device**” top right to make sure bluebook will work.

Arrival & Dismissal

- Morning Exams will begin at **8:00 AM**, sharp. Please arrive no later than **7:40 AM** for your AM exam.
- Afternoon exams will begin at **12:00 PM**, sharp. Please arrive no later than **11:40 AM** for your PM exam.
- AP exams frequently last over 3 hours. For afternoon exams, this will likely require you to be at school past 2:30 PM. Please coordinate transportation with this in mind.
- **No student will be allowed to leave the testing room early. You will not have any phone access whatsoever during testing, so transportation should be coordinated before the start of your exam.**

What to bring with you on exam day

- Two No. 2 pencils, sharpened (**NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**)
- A blue or black pen
- An approved calculator for relevant exams [AP Calculator Policy](#)
- **School issued ID**

Digital Exams/Hybrid Exams

- **MUST ARRIVE WITH A FULLY CHARGED IPAD**
- **Must arrive with charging cord and AC adapter**
- **Must have a working external keyboard (please check prior to exam day)**
- **Students MUST HAVE their College Board account sign in credentials prior to entering the testing site.**

Personal Items

- **Please leave bookbags, cell phones, and smart watches in your locker prior to entering the testing room.**
- Water and snacks must be brought to the room if you want to have access to them during your break.
- Students who miss their lunch period due to testing will be allowed to eat in the lunchroom either after their morning test or before their afternoon test.
- Be mindful that shifts in temperature can impact testing rooms. Wear or bring appropriate layers of clothing to account for this.
- *Students are responsible for completing any assigned work they may have missed due to a scheduled AP exam.*
