Mount Pleasant, SC - Wando High School is excited to announce the appointment of John Reynolds as the new Head Boys' Basketball Coach. With over a decade of coaching at the collegiate level, Coach Reynolds brings a wealth of experience.

A proud alumnus of The Citadel, where he played four years and earned All-Academic Southern Conference honors, Reynolds spent the last 13 years rising through the ranks of NCAA Division I basketball. Most recently, he served as the Associate Head Coach at The Citadel, where he was instrumental in recruiting, overseeing strategic planning initiatives, skill development, and scouting.

Reynolds also served under Coach Frank Martin at the University of South Carolina, helping lead the Gamecocks to 75 wins, including three top-six finishes in the Southeastern Conference standings. As Director of On-Campus Recruiting, he played a vital role in the recruitment and development of eight future NBA players in his five seasons with the Gamecocks.
