Action (Consent): 9. Authorization to Submit an Other Capital Projects Application to the NJ Department of Education Without State Funding

WHEREAS, the Kingsway Regional Board of Education (the "Board") has identified the need for certain capital improvements to district facilities, which are necessary to maintain and improve the learning environment for students; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that these improvements constitute "Other Capital Projects" as defined by the New Jersey Department of Education ("NJDOE"), meaning that the projects will not require state funding; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:26-3.1 et seq., all capital projects must be submitted to the NJDOE for review and approval prior to implementation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the district to proceed with the submission of these Other Capital Projects for NJDOE approval without seeking State funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Kingsway Regional, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Board hereby authorizes the submission of the following Other Capital Projects to the NJDOE for review and approval:
 - Hot water heater replacements at the Middle and High Schools
 - Corridor Enhancements in the 400 wing of the High School



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- Middle School East Gymnasium Rooftop HVAC Unit Replacement
2. The Board confirms that no State funding is being requested for these projects, and that all costs will be funded through local sources, including but not limited to capital reserve funds, general fund appropriations, or other legally available funds.
 3. The Board authorizes the Superintendent, Business Administrator, and other appropriate district personnel to take all necessary steps to prepare and submit the required applications, documentation, and supporting materials to the NJDOE for review and approval.
 4. The Board further authorizes the district's architectural and engineering professionals to prepare all necessary plans, specifications, and related documents in compliance with NJDOE requirements.

Action (Consent): 10. Award of Construction Contract for Summer 2025 Renovations

WHEREAS, the Kingsway Regional School District Board of Education (the "Board"), in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-1 et seq., publicly advertised for bids for Summer 2025 Renovations (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2025, the Board received and opened competitive bids for the Project in accordance with the Public School Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, Dandrea Construction submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$1,410,000, which has been reviewed and determined to be responsive to the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Board's professional staff, including its architect, have reviewed the bid submissions and recommend awarding the contract to Dandrea Construction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Kingsway Regional School District Board of Education, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The contract for Summer 2025 Renovations is hereby awarded to Dandrea Construction in the total amount of \$1,410,000, subject to execution of a mutually acceptable contract and compliance with all applicable legal requirements.
2. The Board President, Business Administrator/Board Secretary, and other appropriate district personnel are authorized to execute the contract and take all necessary actions to facilitate the commencement and completion of the Project.
3. The Board's architect and legal counsel are directed to coordinate with the awarded contractor to ensure compliance with all project specifications, timelines, and statutory obligations.
