# Reading

# Students will:

- Recognize and name all upper and lowercase letters of the alphabet.
- Recognize, write and identify sounds of letters as introduced.
- Sound out, read, and write consonant vowel consonant (CVC) words.
- Read all high frequency words learned to date.
- Count, segment and blend syllables.
- Produce and identify rhyming words.
- · Identify and name ending punctuation.
- Compose and correctly write a sentence.
- Identify character, setting, main idea, and details of fictional and non-fiction stories.
- Distinguish between similarly spelled words.

## Math

# Students will:

- Counting to 100
- Writing and Identifying numbers 0 − 20.
- Orally counting a set of 20 objects saying the number names in order.
- Sorting and Classifying Objects into categories according to shape, size, and color.
- Describing the relative positions of objects using terms such as above, below, in front of, behind, and next to.
- Representing addition with objects and fluently adding with a sum no greater than 5.
- Representing subtraction with objects and fluently subtracting with 5 being the largest number in the problem.
- Identifying whether the number of objects is greater than, less than, or equal to the number of objects in another group.




