January 21-February 21, 2025: Applications for Schools of Choice may be dropped off in the lock box at the MUSD Enrollment Center, 5297 Maureen Lane, Moorpark, (805) 378-6300.

March 21, 2025: Lottery results for Walnut Canyon and Flory (only) mailed to parents. All other school transfer notifications will be mailed to parents on June 20, 2025. *Transportation for school transfers is not provided by the District.

In order to register for school, the following information is required:

1) Proof of birth (example: birth certificate, baptismal certificate, passport)

2) Proof of residency (example: utility bill, escrow papers, lease agreement)

3) Immunization record (immunizations must be up to date or student will be placed on a waiting list)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCHOOL OF CHOICE (TK-5th Grade)

Applications for School of Choice transfers must be submitted to the Enrollment Center.

- To request a school transfer, both the online registration process and an application for School of Choice must be completed. School of Choice applications are available digitally and on paper. Paper applications are to be dropped off in the lock box at the MUSD Enrollment Center by 4:00 p.m. on February 21, 2025. Late applications will be placed on a waiting list.
- 2. Indicate your choice of schools in the order of preference beginning with 1 as first choice, 2 as second choice, etc. Applicants are not required to make more than one choice.
- 3. You must fill out a separate application for each child. Priority is given to siblings to attend the same school if a parent chooses that option and space is available.
- 4. If you are selected for one of the open enrollment magnet schools (Flory Academy of Sciences and Technology or Walnut Canyon School of Performing Arts and Technology), you will be notified by mail on March 21, 2025. *All other approved School of Choice transfers will be notified June 20, 2025. It is not possible to predict the likelihood of approval as this depends on the number of students at each grade level that move in or out, and the number of applications received.
- 5. Once a student is accepted in a School of Choice, the spot vacated at the neighborhood school will be given to another student. Students may attend the school of choice for the duration of their elementary school years. Applications will not need to be filled out again once the student has been accepted.
- 6. Students selected for a school transfer will not be enrolled until all immunizations are up to date. Students will remain on a waiting list and may lose their seat in their preferred school if immunizations are incomplete.
- 7. For students that receive Special Education services, school placement will be a team decision based on the educational needs of the student.
- 8. If you are not selected for the school of your choice, your child will be placed on a waiting list and you will be contacted in August if an opening becomes available. If not selected, you may also reapply to your school of choice the following school-year.
- 9. It should be noted that the District reserves the authority to maintain appropriate diversity. Final decisions will be made on space availability at each school site and the need to maintain diversity and equitable class sizes throughout the District.

Parents are invited to attend Information Night presentations for **Walnut Canyon Elementary on January 21th** at 6:00 p.m. English/7:00 p.m. Spanish and for **Flory Academy on January 22th** at 6:00 p.m. English/7:00 p.m. Spanish to learn more about educational experiences offered at these schools. Contact the school for tour information.

Tours for TK-5th grade will be offered at all six elementary schools. Information for school tours will be posted on each of the elementary school websites and social media pages. Contact the school office to sign-up for a tour.
