


7061 Total Rostered Student-Athletes in 2023-24 Participation by Level




- 2.777 NCAA G.P.A. (2021-22, 2.573 NCAA G.P.A.)


Elementary Data

- Co-Ed Elementary Football is entering its 4th year, partnering with NIFA, P.A.L., C.Y.O., Southwest Allen School District and East Allen

 Boys & Girls Basketball School District. This past Fall, we had:
 - ➤ 67 1st & 2nd Graders participate in Flag Football
 - ➤ 202 3rd-5th Graders participate in modified Football
 - ➤ **269** Total FWCS Elementary students
- **Elementary Pipeline Club Wrestling** will be entering the 4th year, as we continue to build on the infrastructure of the programs.
 - ➤ 165 Elementary Club Wrestlers (an increase of 45 student-athletes from last year.)
- Boys & Girls Basketball
 - > 255 elementary boys and girls participated
 - > 18 Total Teams (increase of 6 teams from last year)
- Co-Ed Elementary Basketball
 - > 270 participants
 - > 18 Teams (decrease of 4 teams from last year)









FWCS Athletic Pipeline Strategy

The overarching goal is to empower the high school head coach and implement strategic development plans for all respected pipelines, creating lower-level developmental leagues that edify education-based athletics for student-athletes from 1st to 8th grade.

Benefits of Pipeline Development:

- Strengthening & edifying the vertical articulation
- Retain student-athletes potentially leaving the FWCS District
- Attract & Enroll student-athletes from competing districts at an earlier age
- Develop skill improve individual skill to contribute to the team concept
- Evaluate performance continued assessments of agility, strengths, and skill throughout the FWCS tenure
- Provide opportunities provide a competitive edge for student-athletes as they mature through amateur sports
