The MasteryConnect Parent Portal allows you to access your child's progress in *real time*. As your student learns and becomes proficient in concepts and standards throughout the year, you can stay updated.

As soon as you sign in, you'll get an overall view of your child's current classes and a quick glimpse of how many standards have been completed in each one. To view classes from past years, click Archived Classes.

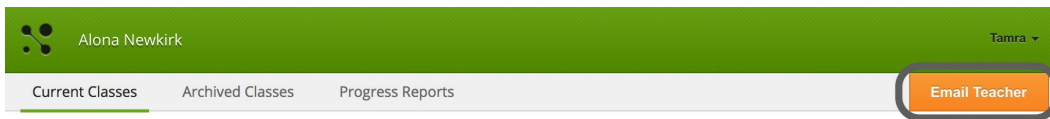
