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A Peek At What We Are Learning

ELA	Wonders and iReady - Point of View, Analyzing Accounts of the Same Event or Topic, and Analyze Visual Elements in Literary Text (RL.CS.6; RI.CS.6; RL.IK1.7) Grammar – Prepositions and Writing Elements
Math	Module 4 & 5 – Multiply fractions and whole numbers, and Fractions by fractions/decimals, and Metric and Customary Conversions; Volume, Area, and Attributes of Polygons
Science	5.PS1.1 –Matter and its interactions. Physical properties of matter; phases between solids, liquids, and gases. Evaluate the results of an experiment to determine whether the mixing of two or more substances result in a change of properties.
Social Studies	Events leading to U.S. entry into World War I, locate the major countries during World War I, describe the impact of U.S. involvement on World War I. Students will also describe Tennessee's contributions during World War I, World War II, and the Great Depression.
