SCHOLARSHIP

The academic requirements are a 3.0 GPA and a minimum 18 ACT. The scholarship portion of the program is funded by the universities and is only a portion of the total financial aid package. The scholars must fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The Excel scholarship is then added to all state, federal, and other outside scholarships/grants and work study. To retain the scholarship, students are required to remain active in the program and maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout their undergraduate studies.
