

## MEET Mrs. Barringer

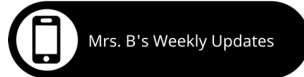
Welcome to 5<sup>th</sup> grade! This year is going to be filled with learning and growth opportunities. I'm glad to be part of the journey!

I LOVE sports! Basketball is my favorite with Football and Soccer close behind.

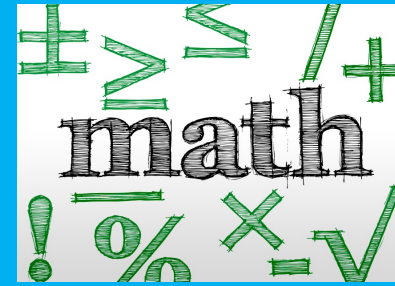
Some ways that I spend my time are reading, gardening and kayaking.

Work is due Friday

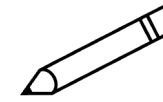
**LATE WORK:** We have due dates for a reason. However, I will accept late work for up to 2 days after the due date. 10 points will be deducted for each day the assignment is late.

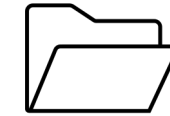

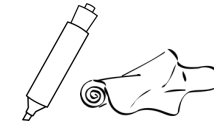
