PAPER POT SEED STARTERS

Give your flowers a head start and plant their seeds inside in early spring. You can make your own pots out of old newspaper.

What You Need:

- newspaper
- soil
- 5.5-ounce (156-gram) juice can
- flower seeds



- 1 Rip newspaper into three-inch-wide (8-centimeter-wide) strips.
- 2 Take a newspaper strip and roll it around the juice can, leaving about 1.5 inches (4 cm) of newspaper hanging over the bottom.
- 3 Fold the extra newspaper against the bottom of the juice can to create a flat, solid bottom.
- 4 Turn the can upright and press down firmly.
- 5 Remove the juice can. You have made a newspaper pot!
- 6 Fill each pot with soil. Stop a half an inch (1.3 cm) from the top. Plant your seeds following packet instructions.
