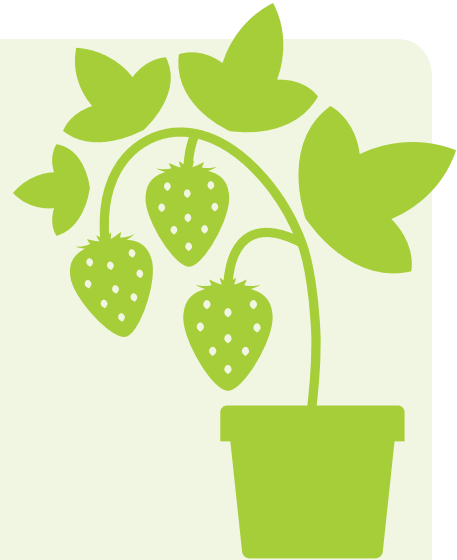
GROW YOUR OWN STRAWBERRIES

You don't need a lot of space to grow your own strawberries. You can grow them in a pot in a sunny window. Here's how:

What You Need:

- young strawberry plant (You can purchase one online or from your local garden shop or transplant one from another garden.)
- gravel
- garden soil
- pot

- 1 Put a layer of gravel about a half inch (1.3 centimeters) deep in a pot. This will give the soil good drainage.
- 2 Put a little soil in the pot. Push the soil away toward the edges of the pot to create a hole in the center.
- 3 Add a small mound of soil in the middle of the hole.
- 4 Lower the plant into the pot. Set the plant on the mound in the center of the hole. Fan the roots down the side of the mound.
- 5 Fill in the hole with soil. Then fill the pot up to the base of the plant's stem. Pat the soil down.
- 6 Make sure the plant stays moist and gets plenty of sun.
- 7 Keep it up! In three months you should have berries!
