PLANT RADISH SEEDS

Radishes are one of the first vegetables to harvest in the spring. Start them inside, and soon you will have a crunchy treat. Here's how:

What You Need:

- a large pot
- a few stones
- compost
- radish seeds

- 1 Put a few stones in the bottom of a large pot. This lets water drain.
- 2 Fill your pot with compost. Put your radish seeds in the compost about one quarter inch (.6 centimeters) deep.
- 3 Put your pot in a sunny spot. Water your seeds whenever the compost seems dry.
- 4 Once your radishes begin to grow, take out some of the seedlings. Plant them outside about an inch (2.5 cm) apart. This gives them room to grow.
- 5 In about four weeks, your radishes will be ready to pick!
- 6 Enjoy them raw or sliced on a salad. Congratulations! You grew them yourself.



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
