

GCSE Results Day – 21 August 2025

I am sure this summer will include some anxious moments as your child awaits their examination results; however, we will do our utmost to ensure that their transition to Felsted is a calm and supportive experience.

As you are aware, the normal entrance criteria to Felsted in September is subject to your child achieving the minimum of 32 points over 6 subjects at GCSE / IGCSE and the entry requirements for the subjects they have chosen to study at IB or A Level as specified in the Sixth Form Subject Guide (for most subjects this as at least a 6). We will want to confirm courses with all candidates, especially where candidates have not met the entry requirement, but might still have a viable Sixth Form course.

Please also note that in some subjects, particularly Maths and Sciences, we would expect pupils to have achieved at least grade 7 in that subject at GCSE. Therefore, should a pupil not meet that requirement, we would encourage pupils to have considered an alternative option ready to discuss with the Academic Office on the results day.

Therefore, we ask that a scanned copy of your child's Statement of Results is emailed to us as a matter of urgency by lunchtime on 21 August to enable a member of staff to speak to you if required.

We also require copies of all GCSE/IGCSE certificates to be sent once they are published, together with the UCI number (The Unique Candidate Identifier 12 digit number followed by a capital letter) and these can also be emailed as above.

Please note: if we do not receive the Statement of Results, your child will not be permitted to start at Felsted.
