History/Growth/Admissions

Thomas Mckean High School was established in December 1966, with its inaugural class graduating in June 1967. Originally designed for flexible scheduling, the school expanded in 1972 by adding a new wing and incorporating ninth grade, making the class of 1976 the first to attend all four years at Mckean. Over the years, the school has undergone various renovations, including updates to laboratories. Additionally, Mckean has established partnerships to enhance educational opportunities; for instance, beginning in Fall 2024, the school offers the Early College Academy in collaboration with Goldey-Beacom College, allowing students to enroll in college-level courses during high school.
