Fees (one time only to cover all years of membership):

- **\$15 required membership fee.** This goes towards materials and registration in the organization.
- **\$25 additional, optional stole fee.** This will provide senior members with a graduation stole to wear at the ceremony. Members dismissed from the organization prior to graduation will not be refunded.
- Payments may be paid by cash or check (made payable to Mill Valley High School)

Requirements for Meetings:

- Tuesday morning meetings at 7:20 am (approximately 7 or 8 meetings per semester). Please be prompt. Two tardies = one absence.
- Students are allowed 1 absence per semester. 2 absences = probation period. 3 or more = hearing for dismissal.
- There are no "excused" versus "unexcused" absences.

Requirements Throughout the Year:

- Members must obtain 10 hours of community service **per semester**. You may use hours served for Mrs. Jones' community service class that occur outside of the school hours. Hours need to be acquired through genuine community service. See "Service Hour Clarifications" on MV NHS webpage.
- Members must attend at least **two** group-sponsored events per semester. All approved group events will be listed on the MV NHS webpage.
- Members must sustain a cumulative **unweighted** GPA consistent with the requirement for application.
- Members must sustain high standards of character and leadership throughout their membership. This includes but is not limited to showing up to any and all events in which he/she has committed.

Dismissal:

- First violation of attendance (2 absences), character, leadership, and/or GPA requirements will result in a probationary warning. Teacher or community member reports of lack of character/ leadership may count as a violation. Grade checks can be run as frequently as once per quarter. The member will have the probationary period to move back into good standing with the organization.
- Second violation of attendance, community service hours, group event, character or leadership, and/or GPA requirements will result in dismissal from the NHS organization.
- Engagement in **any** illegal activity (i.e. drug/alcohol possession, drug/alcohol use, possession of a weapon) on or off campus, or at a school sponsored activity, will result in immediate dismissal from the NHS organization.
- SENIOR members of NHS in violation of the community service hours and/or the group event requirement will not be recognized as a member of NHS during the graduation ceremony.

REMEMBER: As a member of National Honor Society, you are to represent the 4 pillars of the organization both in and out of school.
