Lakewood Local Schools Board of Education Closes Sale of Hebron Elementary School Building

The Lakewood Local Schools Board of Education closed the sale of 709 Deacon Street, Hebron, Ohio – formerly the site of Hebron Elementary School – on Thursday, April 24. The board approved a resolution authorizing the execution of a letter of intent for the potential sale of real property owned by the board at a special meeting February 7. The school building was vacated at the end of the 2022-2023 school year and decommissioned. All students formerly housed at Hebron Elementary School (K-2) were moved into a building comprised of Jackson Intermediate B and modular structures connecting to the existing building, now known as Lakewood Elementary School at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.

“The Board is appreciative to Shai-Hess for identifying a buyer and achieving our goal of a fair price for the property,” said Jon Lynch, Lakewood Local Schools Board of Education President. “We believe we have shown good financial stewardship to all of the villages and townships that comprise the Lakewood Local School District, and we look forward to seeing what becomes of the site for the Village of Hebron.”

Lakewood Local Schools sold the property listed by Shai-Hess Commercial Real Estate, LLC, to Mr. Damien Merk for \$400,000.

"Hebron Elementary served us well for more than 100 years and it is heartening to see it will have a new life moving forward," said Interim Superintendent Scott Coffey.
