Prevention of Sexual Misconduct Toward Students, Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse, Child Neglect, and Corporal Punishment

The District prohibits and will not tolerate any form of sexual misconduct (including lewdness, sexual abuse, sexual molestation, sexual harassment, and luring of a child) child abuse, child neglect, or corporal punishment toward students (regardless of age) on the part of district employees, administrators, officials, volunteers, or third parties.

This policy expands upon, and is established in addition to, the District policy on anti-harassment. Because the District has a particular interest in maintaining student safety and well-being, it has established this additional policy to specifically address sexual misconduct, child abuse, child neglect, and corporal punishment toward students.

If the alleged discrimination could constitute sexual harassment under Title IX, the *Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Sex Under Title IX* policy and administrative regulations apply rather than the *Prevention of Sexual Misconduct Toward Students, Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse, Child Neglect, and Corporal Punishment* policy and administrative regulations.
