KCISD Chromebook 1:1 Insurance Program

Kirbyville CISD offers optional insurance to parents of students who are in grades 4 - 12 who will have a Chromebook checked out to them to be able to take home for school work.

- Cost to participate in the program
 - \$20 per Chromebook
 - Chromebook insurance may be purchased at One Stop Registration, at the time of checkout, or within a week of the date the Chromebook is checked out (for mid-year check-outs).
- o Period of Coverage
 - The Chromebook will be covered for the current school year in which insurance was purchased. (Coverage is not retroactive.)
- o Insurance Covers accidental damage to the Chromebook for the current school year.
 - Coverage includes accidental damage such as:
 - Drops: Cracked screens, Keyboard Damage
 - Liquid Spills
 - Liquid Submersion
 - Fire/Flood Damage
 - Natural Disasters
 - The power adapter is not covered under insurance.
 - Loss and theft are not covered under insurance.
- How to report an issue:
 - Students will submit the damaged Chromebook to their Campus librarian and will complete a Chromebook Repair Form and explain in detail how the damage occurred.
- o If damage is determined to be malicious/vandalistic in nature, then repairs *will not* be covered under the insurance and repair costs will be the responsibility of the parent.
 - The most common repair items are listed below (parts pricing will be determined by the cost of the parts at the time of repair):

 Screen Bezel 	\$17.00
• Outer Top or Bottom Cover	\$30.00
 Display Screen 	\$25.00
 Keyboard or Touchpad 	\$40.00
• Motherboard Replacement	\$100.00
• Chromebook Replacement	\$200.00
(if destroyed, lost, or stolen)

Prices may change based on parts availability

Insurance coverage in no way supersedes the Texas State and KCISD District requirement that all educational equipment, including textbooks and electronic devices, that are checked out for student use **must be returned in good working order**.
