Overview of the FY26 Proposed Budget

- First Reading of the FY26 School Budget proposal was passed by the School Board on March 20, 2025 (meeting slide deck)
- ➤ Full Municipal Budget was presented to the Town Council and public on March 26, 2025, and passed in first reading by the Town Council on April 2, 2025

The School Budget proposal is being refined and updated as we move toward the Board's Second Reading and vote on May 1, 2025.

Items in Motion

Responsive both to new information received and review by Town and School Finance Committees, we adjust our budget between first and second readings.

To date, items in motion include:

- Anthem premium rates received increase of 10.714% vs. estimated 8% adds \$219,000
- ➤ Delta Dental increase will be +2.47%, budgeted for +5.5%, saving \$8,100
- ➤ Work Comp estimate decreased by \$62,100 based on new MOD rating & MEMIC estimates
- Special Services add 2.0 ed tech positions and 1 additional tuition slot for new students \$185,000
- ➤ Pre-K grant funding from DOE has been reduced, leaving ~ \$70,000 unfunded.
 - Plan to create reserve fund with unused FY25 funds to cover shortfall.

All adjustments are presented to the Board for amendments at Second Reading.



Items in Motion - Pre-K Program

SCHOOL BOARD ACTION ITEM FOR APRIL 17, 2025

Motion to establish a new Pre-K Program Reserve Fund in accordance with Title 20-A MRSA §1491

- Year-end transfer of unused local Pre-K funds budgeted in FY25 (~\$150,000)
- Local funds not expended due to availability of DOE grant after budget approval
- Plan to use fund as a revenue source for FY26 Pre-K, to replace lost grant revenue
