- The entire county removed the media specialist para pro positions and instead added an MTSS position. We have purchased this position in past.
- Our bilingual liaison is remaining at 1 which we gained during the year this year
- For custodial we buy contract cleaning
- Mrs. French spoke about the current number of students who receive interventions. We have students who are ESOL but need additional support but we need to serve more students, but we only earned 1 EIP teacher. Having a combination of ESOL and EIP we could have someone who can help serve students in both areas, but mostly serve students in ESOL who also may need EIP in another subject.
- Mrs. Lemons believe people make the biggest impact on students. Buying an additional person allows our teachers to serve the majority of their students, and the additional person can target students who need more specific 1-1 needs.
