Spring Gala

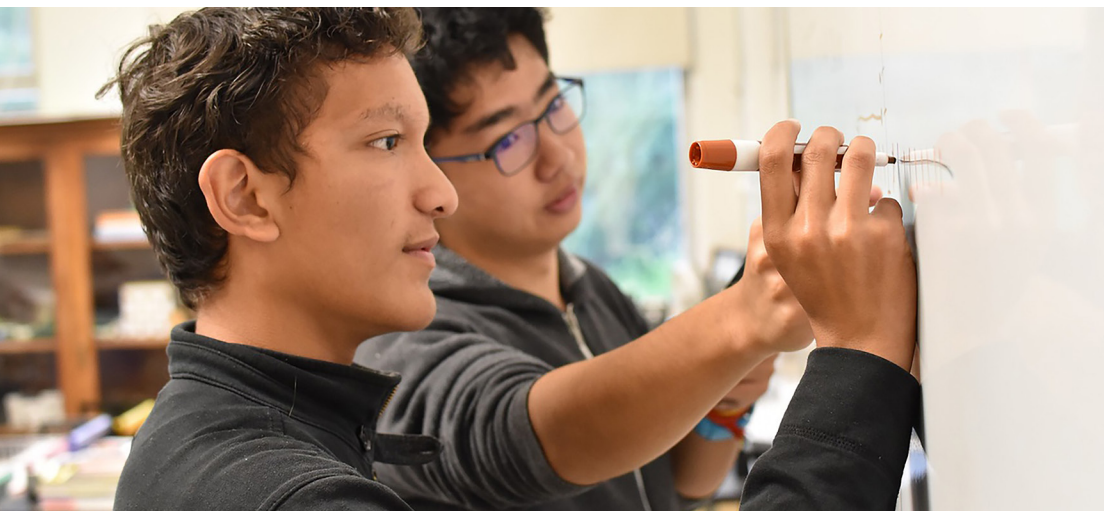
