Seniors will be graduating at the Daniel Teicheira Memorial Stadium at 7:00 pm on Thursday, May 22, 2025. They will receive 9 tickets beginning May 21st and must be clear on the Senior Clear List. **There will be no extra tickets.**

- Adults and children over 2 will need a ticket to enter, please do not save seats for late arrivals.
- Parking is extremely limited and will fill up quickly.
- No sitting or standing along the fence line. All guests must be seated in the bleachers.
- Food and drinks are prohibited in the stands.
- No balloons, beach balls or noise makers are allowed in the stadium.
- The intent of Sierra High School is that our event is dignified and honorable.

We will advise our seniors that they do not have to participate if they object to the ceremonial aspect of graduation. We will encourage everyone to conduct their celebrations after the ceremony. We are asking you, as parents/guardians, to support us in this solemn event by discussing behavioral expectations with your student. It is also important that students realize invited family and friends will be in attendance to watch them receive their diploma, and we do not want anyone to be embarrassed by inconsiderate or inappropriate actions of other graduates during the ceremony.

It is the policy of Sierra High that all graduates clear their absences (including single periods), bills, fines, Saturday Schools, and other obligations by May 22, at 8:30 **AM** if they plan to participate in the ceremony. We will post the Senior Clear List every week beginning May 1st and update the list frequently. It is the responsibility of the senior to check this list at each posting to make sure they are clear and remain so.
