#### **DUAL CREDIT – COLLEGE COURSES**

#### Did you request a <u>Dual Credit college course</u> next year at Catawba Ridge?

<u>Dual Credit College Courses</u> – Are you taking a dual credit college course next year at Catawba Ridge? USC-L, York Tech, and Winthrop require students to apply to the college as a dual enrolled student before taking a dual credit college class. <u>Students MUST apply to the college for dual</u> <u>credit courses and be officially "admitted" before enrolling in Dual Credit college courses through</u> <u>Catawba Ridge</u>. The deadline to complete the dual credit college application is **May 15, 2025**. See the Guidance website, under <u>College Credit Courses</u>, for more details on the application process and procedures specific to each college.

\*Please note that many questions on the college application will need **parent assistance** since several questions ask about SC residency - including SC driver's license, vehicle registration, tax information, etc. Please assist your student in completing this college application. Colleges ask SC residency questions, so that SC LTAP Funds (SC Lottery Tuition Assistance Program) can be used to cover tuition.






