Ms. Hillman from the University of Findlay will be here May 7 to administer an Accuplacer test to students needing a placement score for CCP math or science next year.

May 12 is Academic Letter Night at 7:00 pm. Students will be mailed and emailed home an invitation letter. To qualify for a letter, students had to have a 3.5 or above quarterly GPA for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd quarter this year, be awarded a scholarship, or earn a cord towards graduation.

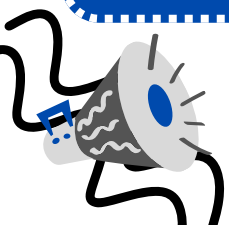
THIS WILL OF COURSE INCLUDE SKITS PERFORMED BY THE STUDENTS!

SPANISH CLASSES

Hola, from the Spanish classroom!

- The Spanish 1 class is learning to read and say the time in Spanish. This month, we will learn more about Mexican culture and the Cinco de Mayo celebration.
- The Spanish 2 class is learning more about Cesar Chavez, Dolores Huerta, the Chicano Movement, which aims to combat racism, discrimination, and economic inequality faced by Mexican Americans in the United States, and the Chicano Art Movement, which gives voice to Chicano culture through art. We had the opportunity to learn and reflect on the movement, its cause, and its achievements. This month, we will write a letter in Spanish to a host family in Spain.
- The Spanish 3 class starts reading the book "Un Principe para Tess." It's about siblings who vacation to Puerto Rico and visit various historical sites. The themes and vocabulary are based on Puerto Rican history and culture. They will also be working on a project where they select a Spanish-speaking country, create a slide with all the required information, and include a postcard from the chosen country.

I'm very excited about my classes. It's been a very competitive year, but one filled with lots of learning and wonderful memories for the future. I look forward to next year in Spanish class with the same enthusiasm.
