Program for 4-Year-Olds and Entering Kindergartners

Program for Entering 1st Graders

Program for Entering 9th, 10th, and 11th Graders

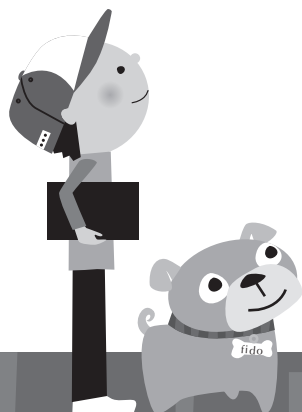
