

## Community Service Form



### **Service requirements:**

**9th grade year:** 10 hours; 11th grade year: 15 hours

**10th grade year:** 10 hours; 12th grade year: 15 hours

**Honors Society:** 30 hours for the year - due by April 3 (no exceptions- approved by Chef Pastor - Honors Society Moderator)

### **Reminders:**

- Community service must be done **OUTSIDE** of the school day.
- **Each time** service is performed, a Community Service Form is to be completed by you and returned to your Theology teacher. A record of your hours is kept by your Theology teacher.
- **If you sign up for school sponsored service and it gets canceled, you will receive ONE hour of service.**
- **Try to turn your Service Forms in by the end of the quarter in which they are completed.** Do not wait until the end of the year to turn in the service hours you completed earlier in the year.
- Each **12th grader** must have hours completed **by May 1<sup>st</sup>** in order to complete your graduation requirements.
- Each **11th, 10th, and 9th graders** must have hours completed **by June 2<sup>nd</sup>** in order to receive your end-of-year report card and be promoted to the next grade.
- If hours are not completed by the end of the year, it is your responsibility to make sure the hours are completed over the summer.
  - You will not be able to begin classes in the new school year until your hours have been completed.
- **Helping family members and/or babysitting are not accepted as service hours.** Helping family is expected of all students.
- If you are not sure what counts as service, please check with your Theology teacher.
- **AWARDS CEREMONY:** awards are given for **30+ and 100+ community service hours.** These hours must be recorded and submitted **by MAY 1<sup>st</sup>** in order to receive an award.
- **HONORS SOCIETY:** If you hope to be inducted into the Honors Society, in addition to maintaining your grades, you must complete 30 hours of service by **APRIL 3.**
