FROM THE NURSE'S DESK

Students entering the 12th grade must show written proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine prior to entering the 12th grade. This proof must be provided to the nurse's office prior to the 2025/2026 distribution days. Please consult with your student's health care provider and consider turning in the documentation **NOW** to the School Nurse if your student is already compliant with this requirement.

An important reminder:

The school required dose must be received on or after age 16.

2025/2026 DISTRIBUTION DAYS
