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### **Research Simulation Task(s)**

Create a diary that represents a different perspective than that of the “single story,” Jewish Holocaust victim. This may be a “victim” of another race, ethnicity, etc., an S.S. guard, a driver of trains, or a doctor who helped sterilize the Jews. Do some research and be creative.

**OR**

Do some more extensive research into the Holocaust. Create a timeline of important events and decide where you might include important events that happen in the novel. Then, write a 2-page paper about how the novel informs your understanding of the Holocaust or how it detracts from your understanding.

### **Narrative**

Write a “This I Believe” speech that involves a specific theme in the novel. Focus on **one** belief or value. This should be evident in your thesis statement. Be sure to use vivid verbs and write in first-person voice. Explain why this belief is important to you, how you came about this belief, etc. Also be sure to explain how you live or want to live by this personal belief.
