Baseball

Our Varsity Baseball team played two games this past week. Last Wednesday (4/23/25) our Rams traveled to Mount Tahoma to take on the T-Birds. Our Rams whitewashed the T-Birds 17 to 0. Yesterday, our Rams traveled to Sehmel Homestead Park in Gig Harbor to take on the Peninsula Seahawks. Our Rams got shutout by the Seahawks 4 to 0.

Yesterday (4/29/25) both our Silas Boys and Girls teams played in the Kitsap Invitational at Gold Mountain Golf Course in Bremerton. In the Boys tournament, 26 teams competed on the Olympic Course. 15 Girls teams competed on the Cascade Course. Unfortunately, we did not have results to share at press time.

Bellevue ran away from the field in last year's 3A Girls State Championship. You may recall Silas finished 3rd in State last year, 88 strokes behind Bellevue. The Wolverines ended last season as the 41st best team in the country! So far this year, the Wolverines are undefeated.

The Boys (7-2) and Girls will close out their regular season by hosting the always strong Bellarmine Prep Lions at Allenmore Golf Course on Friday (5/2/25). Post-season play for our Rams begins next Tuesday (5/6/25) when the Puget Sound League Golf Championships take place at Capital City Golf Course in Olympia.
