NASA: Mission to Mars and Beyond Camp

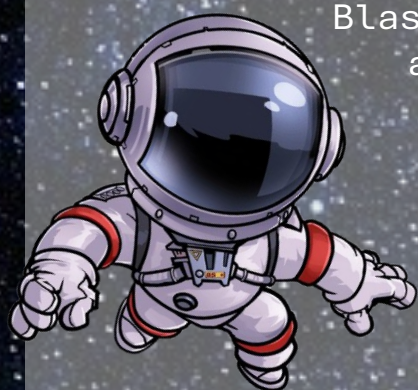

The excitement blasts off with a **real NASA-style rocket launch**, and each camper will return home with exclusive take-home NASA activities to continue the discovery.
