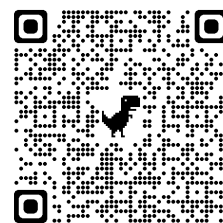

Does your child dream of changing the world? In **Inventor's League**, students in grades 3–6 will step into the shoes of real-world innovators and design creative solutions to global challenges. From brainstorming big ideas to building real prototypes, this camp empowers young minds to think critically, collaborate, and create with purpose. Each day starts with stories of inspiring kid inventors—like the 11-year-old who built a robot to help in natural disasters—showing campers that *they* can make a difference too. Then, students will dive into hands-on activities: researching a real-world problem (in medicine, architecture, the environment, or their own passion area), sketching 2D blueprints, building 3D models, and even creating a website to pitch their final product. Projects will be shared on a secure, password-protected Black Rocket website, so families can celebrate and explore each invention together. Whether your child is a budding engineer, designer, or problem-solver, **Inventor's League** will ignite their imagination and build the skills they'll need for the future. Students must be picked up by an adult 18 years and older—no transportation. Please make sure your child brings a bagged lunch from home.
