

WEST HARTFORD PLAN AND ZONING COMMISSION LEGAL NOTICE

The Town of West Hartford Plan and Zoning Commission also acting as the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency, will hold its Regular Meeting at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, May 5, 2025. Public hearings will convene at 7:15 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in Town Hall, 50 South Main Street, West Hartford, CT, Legislative Chamber, Room 314 on the following:

137 North Main Street – Application (SUP #1448) of The American School for the Deaf, requesting approval of a Special Use Permit to construct a lighted multi-sport court, a multi-use track and synthetic turf infield area, together with associated site grading and drainage.

137 North Main Street – Application (SUP #1429-R1-25) of The American School for the Deaf, requesting approval of a Special Use Permit to construct a new +/-2,442 square foot maintenance garage in lieu of the previously approved, but never built garage in the adjacent parking lot to the east.

20 Jefferson Avenue – Application (SUP #1470) of Kareem Ayodeji, requesting approval of a Special Use Permit to operate a new place of worship in a portion of the existing multi-tenant building.
