#### **PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN** On-Line Registration is available Monday, March 17th

For the 2025-26 school year, children entering Kindergarten must be five years of age on or before August 1, 2025. Also, families may apply for Preschool if their child turns four years old on or before August 1, 2025 and is income-eligible. Three- and four-year-olds who have a special need may also apply for Preschool.
