<b>Scheduling</b>	<a href="#">Master Schedule</a> WINN block is when students are working at their academic level, getting remediation or enrichment Every K-5 classroom has a time in their schedule for Phonics/Morphology (science of reading) Literacy time should total at least 120 minutes each day Math instruction (some lower elementary classrooms have both whole group and small group math instruction); depending on grade level, scheduled from 60-95 minutes Science/Social Studies are when we might see STEAM incorporated into the content Everyone has writing scheduled every day Everyone has lunch/recess scheduled	

	<p>Everyone has 55 minutes of a Specialist time (Phy. Ed., Music, Art, Health)</p> <p>MS–the first three periods of the day are reserved for Electives and Specialist classes; mostly these classes are scheduled by grade level; Heritage class will be offered in MS; any student can choose any Elective regardless of race, language, gender, etc, the only limiting factor may be grade level if the class is only offered to one specific grade; we offer Telescoped Math (doing grade level math at an accelerated pace so progress to the next grade level of math during the same academic year)</p>

<b>Classification</b>	<p><a href="#">Classification Protocol</a>: all staff are involved in determining the best placement for each student to the next grade level, the linked document details the level of work that goes into balancing classrooms; the K team works to classify students into three 1st grade classrooms, 1st grade classifies into 2nd, etc.; many moving parts of the process and we;</p> <p><b>because this process is so involved and we need to create classrooms that are balanced, we are unable to accept requests from parents for specific teachers</b></p>	

	<p>Q: if families make changes to where their children will attend, does the school know? The students are still on the roster.</p> <p>A: sometimes the family lets us know, but we keep them on our roster until we hear from the new school when they request for student records; otherwise they stay on our rolls for at least 15 days to make sure students are enrolled somewhere, depending on the situation the Social Workers will reach out to the family to determine the students whereabouts,</p>
