Math with Mr. Lee and Mr. Klemme:

Hello families!

We recently wrapped up our Percent Unit, where students learned how to find discounts, markups, tips, and calculate percent increase and decrease. We're now diving into our next unit of the year: Probability! Students will explore simple and compound events, and learn how to calculate the likelihood of different outcomes.

As we approach the end of May, students will take an End-of-Year Diagnostic Test to measure the growth they've made in math throughout the year.

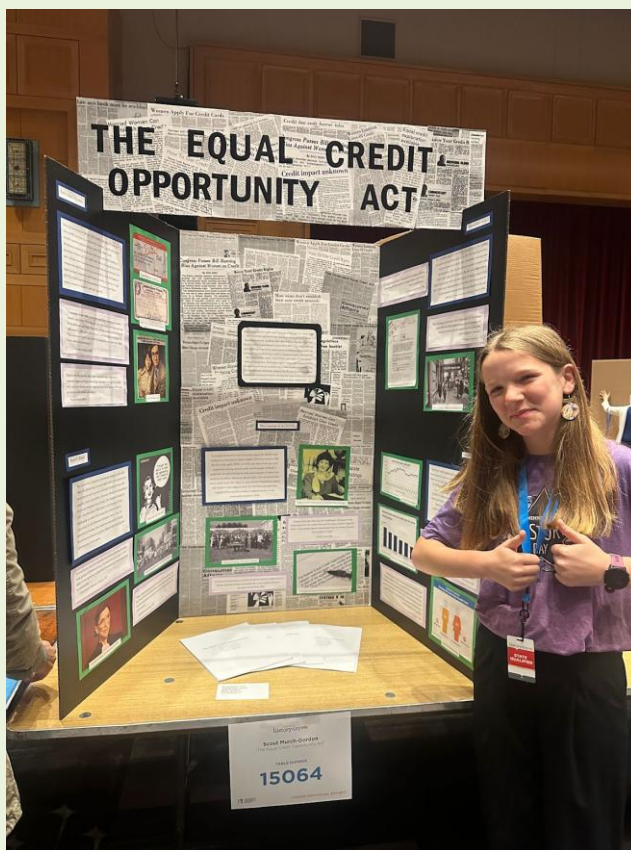

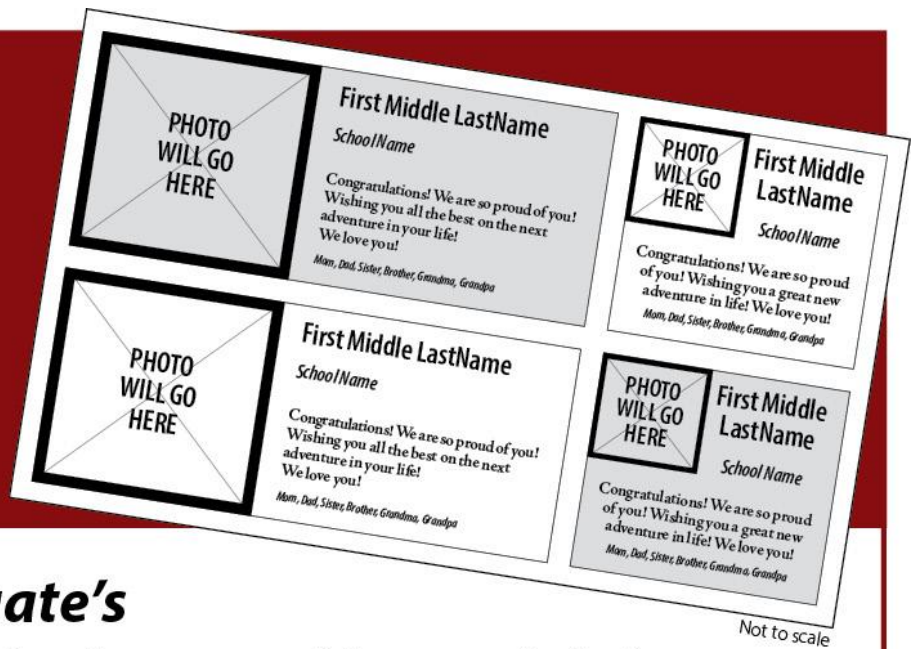
