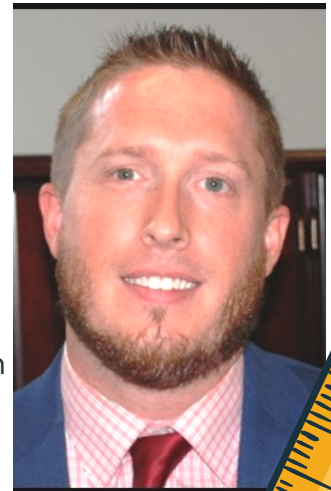


Millwood NEWS
