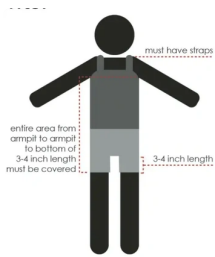

State Testing Continues

California State Testing (also known as SBAC & CAASPP) continues this month. Please support your child's success in the following ways:

- Have your child go to bed early and get a good night's sleep.
- Have your child eat a balanced breakfast with protein before school.
- Make sure your child arrives to school on time. Tardies will mean your child will have to test in our library rather than in their classroom.
- If your child took the state test last year, review their score in Aeries and set a goal for improvement. Teachers are also doing this in class.
- Set high expectations and goals at home and include rewards for reaching their goals.
