AP EXAMS: May 5-16

Starting May 5, 2025, AP exams will be administered according to the official College Board schedule. Students can confirm their specific exam dates by logging into My AP Classroom. As in previous years, the Ramapo Indian Hills High School District will excuse students from the remainder of their classes on the day of their exam.

- For morning exams, students must report to their assigned testing location by 7:35 AM and will be dismissed for the rest of the day once their exam concludes.
- For afternoon exams, students must report by 11:35 AM and will be dismissed at the end of the exam. Students will be excused from their morning classes.

Please note that afternoon exams will likely extend into after-school hours. Students involved in athletics or other extracurricular activities should plan accordingly, as they will not be permitted to leave the exam early.

Important Reminders:

- Students must bring a fully charged laptop and charger on test day. (Exceptions: World Language, Art and Design, and Music Theory exams do not require laptops.)
- Most AP exams include an online component, so students must know their College Board login credentials. The school cannot retrieve login information, so it is essential that students verify access before exam day.
- We recommend students log in to the BlueBook app in advance to practice and confirm they have the correct login details. Saved passwords will not auto-fill on test day.
- AP Art and Design students must check in with their Day-of-Coordinator on May 9 to confirm their portfolio submission is complete. More detailed instructions will be sent directly to these students as we approach this deadline.
- Exam room assignments will be posted outside each school's Guidance Office. Assignments for the second week will be posted during the first week of exams.
- Punctuality is critical. Students who arrive after an exam has started may be denied entry. Be sure to account for time to arrive to your testing location for the assigned time.

These sessions are open to all Ramapo Indian Hills students registered for the Spring 2025 AP exam administration.
