Dear YUSD Families,

This letter is to communicate the district's support for students in the area of social emotional learning. At Yreka Union School District, we are committed to supporting the whole child—academically, socially, and emotionally. We recognize the importance of creating safe, supportive environments where every student feels seen, heard, and valued. That's why Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) is a core part of what we do every day across our schools.

In The Classroom

Our teachers incorporate SEL instruction directly into the classroom (Tier 1), helping students build skills like emotional regulation, empathy, conflict resolution, and responsible decision-making. In addition to our incredible teaching staff, we are proud to have several student support staff members and site administrators who work closely with students to provide additional care and attention.

Additional Supports & Resources

Outside of the classroom, we offer a wide range of additional support. This includes after-school programming, our Student Success Club (held on Saturdays, during some school breaks, and throughout parts of the summer), and access to contracted counseling professionals during the school day for students who may need more personalized support. To ensure students get timely help, our staff can also use a universal referral form to request services—these referrals are reviewed promptly, allowing us to quickly connect students with the care they need. Our district staff meets regularly with our community partners to ensure students and families have access to the support and resources they need.

Community Partners

We are proud to partner with the Siskiyou County Office of Education through their School-Based Mental Health and Wellness Program, which expands the resources available to our students and families. We also work closely with the Karuk Tribe, Siskiyou County Behavioral Health, Child Protective Services, and the Juvenile Division of Siskiyou County Probation. Together, we're building a district where every student is supported in becoming their best self—academically, emotionally, and socially.
