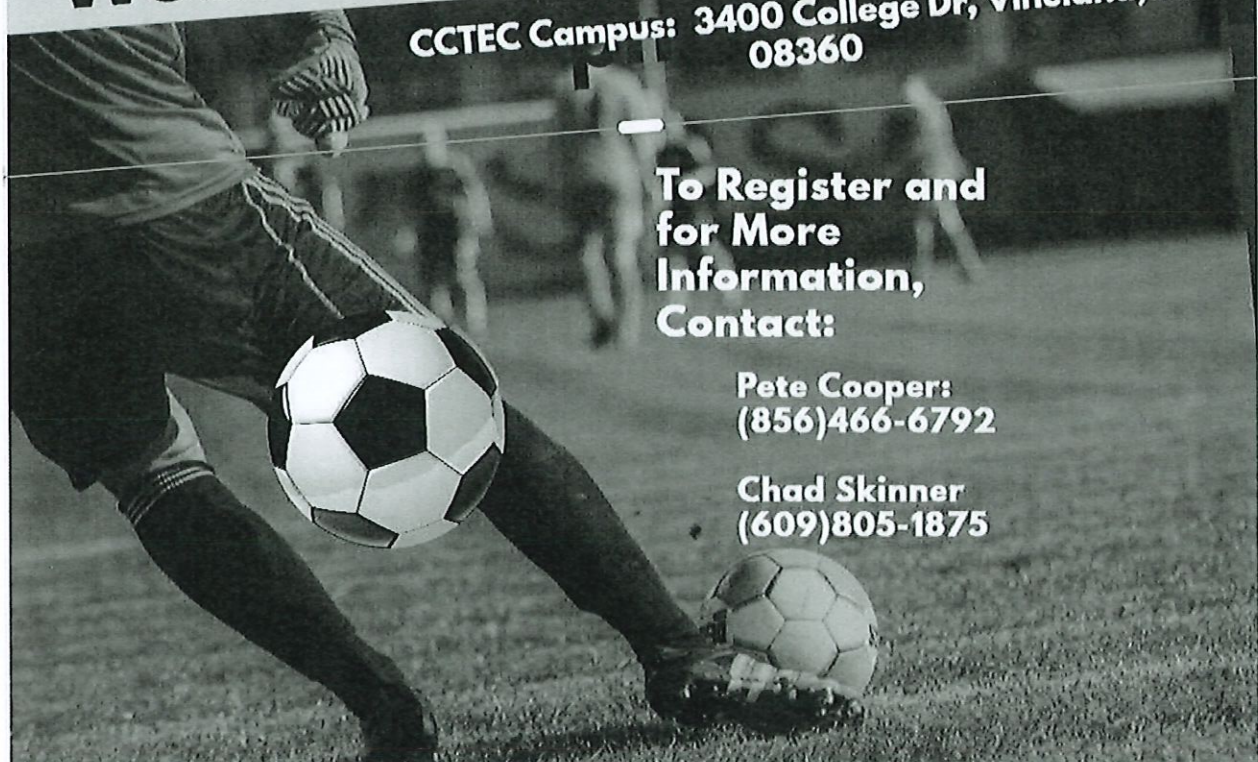

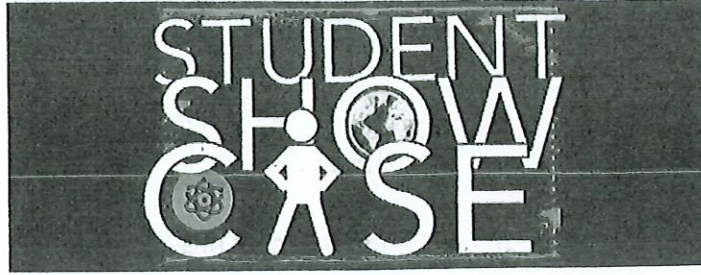

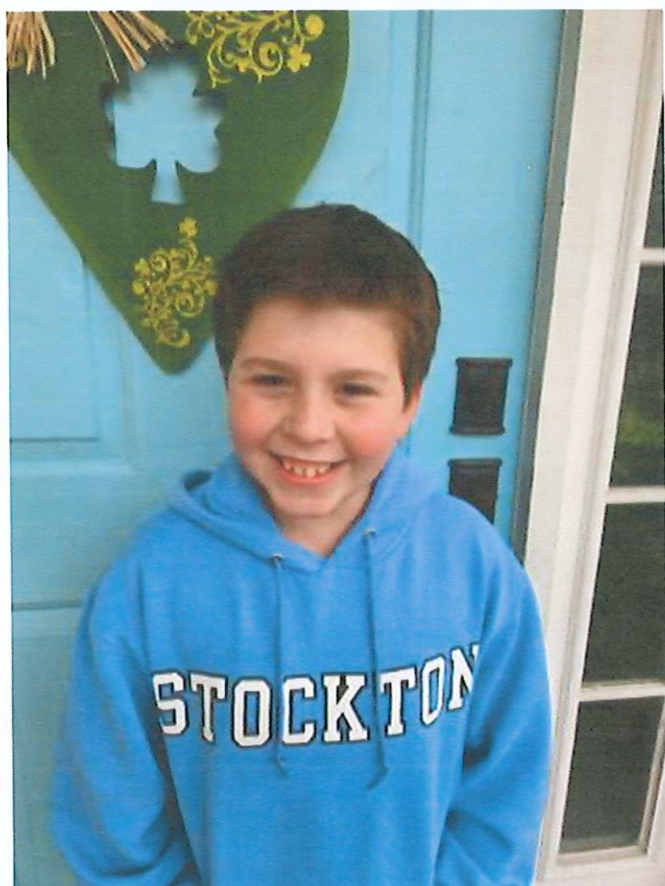

6th Grade, Estell Manor Elementary School, NJ



Cooper was born at CHOP with Tetralogy of Fallot with Pulmonary Atresia. He had a total of 4 heart defects consisting of a hole between his 2 ventricles, an overriding aorta, R ventricular hypertrophy, and no pulmonary artery. Cooper has bravely endured three surgeries including two open heart surgeries, the first when he was 4 days old and the second when he was 7 years old to repair his defects. The surgeries were a success, and Cooper is now feeling stronger than ever! His friends even call him "Super Cooper!" He enjoys playing basketball, soccer, karate, and skiing as well as playing video games and listening to music.

We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of NJSLA Spring 2025 testing administration in the coming weeks ahead. These computer-based assessments, aligned to the New Jersey State Learning standards, will take place on the following dates:

- English Language Arts Grades 3-8
 - May 12th & 13th (AM Testing Sessions)
- Science Grades 5 and 8 only
 - May 14th & 15th (AM Testing Sessions)
- Mathematics Grades 3-8 and Algebra I
 - May 19th, 20th, & 21st (AM Testing Sessions)
- Make Up Testing Grades 3-8
 - May 22nd & 23rd

Please be aware that any student who arrives late to school during test administration will have to make up that particular session. Students who arrive late will wait in the main office until testing is over before reporting to class.

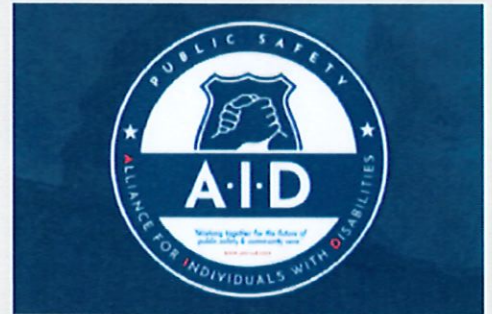

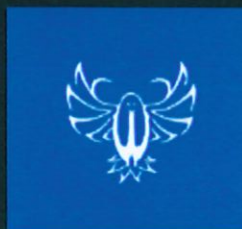
