We are always grateful for our Polton Community. Thank you for all that you do to support Polton! Have a great summer!





Summer EBT provides \$120 per eligible school-aged child to buy more of your family's favorite nutritious food while schools are out on summer break.



What can I buy?

Buy foods like fruits, vegetables, dairy, bread, meat, poultry and fish.
Use Summer EBT at stores that accept SNAP, like grocery or corner stores, and online at King Soopers, Albertsons, Amazon or Walmart.

Your student may be eligible if:

- They attend a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and qualify based on household income
- · The student's family receives SNAP or Colorado Works
- Your student receives Medicaid AND qualifies based on household income using the NSLP income guidelines
- They are in foster care, a migrant, or experiencing homelessness







While issues of grief and loss are hard for anyone to handle, they can be especially painful and confusing for children. Sharing with other children who are in similar situations and knowing that they are not alone can be very helpful. Founded in 1995, Mount Evans Home Health Care & Hospice's bereavement camp has helped more than 2,000 grieving children ages 6 to 12 find a path through their grief. Camp Comfort will be offering two weekend long camps in the mountains and one day camp for three days in metro Deriver this summer. Children learn ways to cope with their grief through workshops and activities, building skills to help them now and throughout their lives.
